# LETTER FROM THE PROVOST

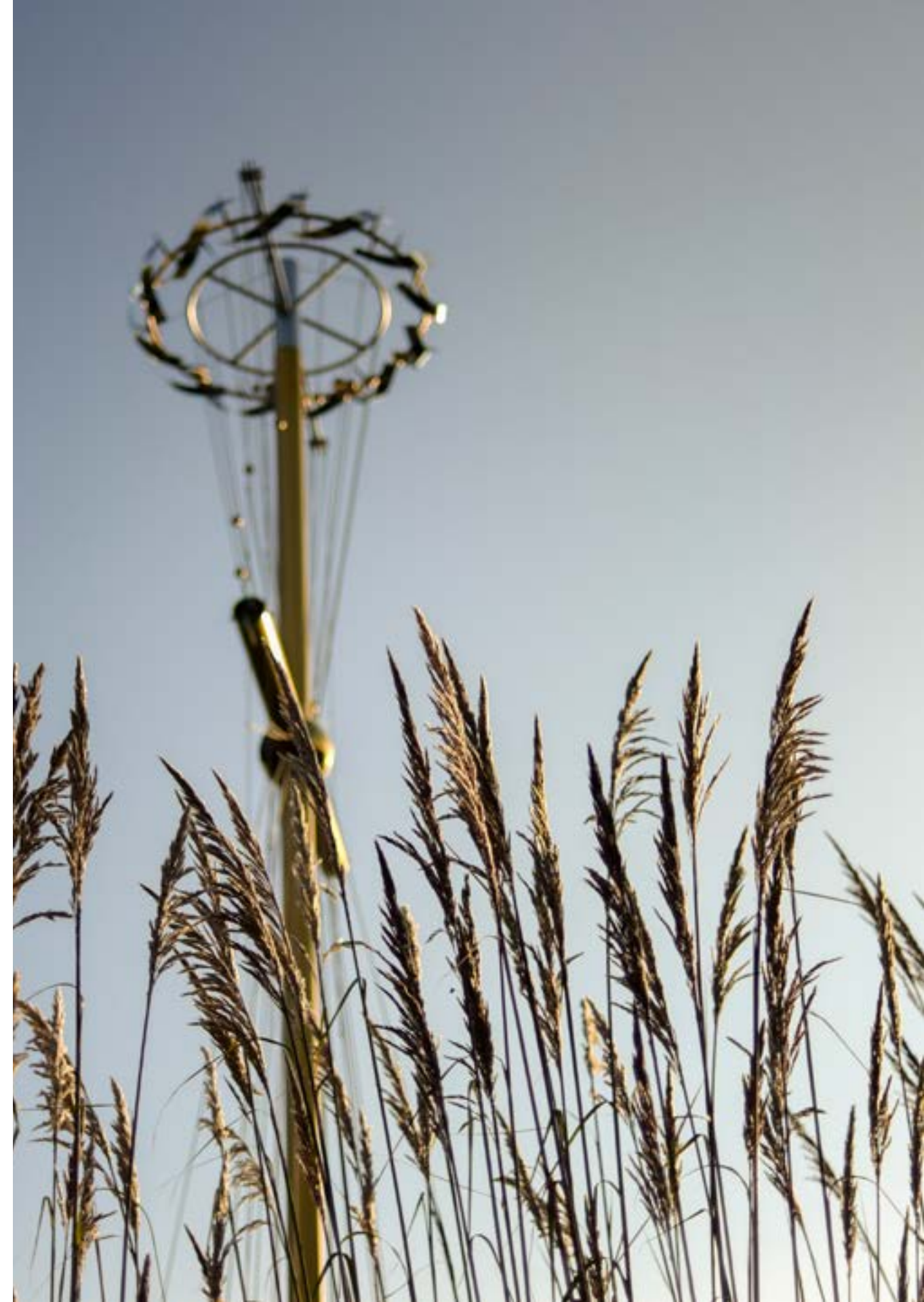
