



BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree enhances professional development for community college transfer students earning an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree while honing their leadership skills to succeed in an array of career fields including social services, corporate or nonprofit management, government, criminal justice and security. This degree prepares the adult student for numerous career horizons by enhancing cognitive skills in management, leadership, critical thinking, writing and communication.
