Description of Placement and Population Served: Alternative Homes for Youth specializes in working with juveniles with problem sexual behavior, psychological and emotional struggles, and conduct disorders. We provide individualized treatment plans that may include individual, group and family therapy, as well as independent living coaching and support, within residential, butpatient, or day treatment formats. All of our care providers use a multi-modal, strengths-based approach. Our treatment philosophy focuses on healing the internal and external systems of our youth in the service of creating mental and emotional wellness, effecting lasting behavioral change, and empowering these young men to make positive choices and create their own healthy futures.	
We serve male youth (ages 14-20) who have a history of sexually abusive behaviors, and their families. The range of issues our clients present with includes: history of significant to severe rauma, neglect and abuse; sexual offending behaviors; deficits in social development and communication skills, empathy, and accountability; conduct disorder; transition; grief and loss; and other mental health issues.
