#### **2020-2011 INTERNSHIPS**

The Jefferson Center for Mental Health offers internships for 2<sup>nd</sup> year graduate students in counseling, social work and psychology, as well as limited internships for bachelor level and 1<sup>st</sup> year graduate students. #### Requirements include:

- 1. Background checks, orientation and trainings prior to start date.
- 2. Commitment of at least two semesters (30 weeks)
- 3. Commitment of 15-20 hours per week
- 4. Vacation time to be negotiated according to clinical needs

Interns complete the placement with one treatment team, unless otherwise determined at the time of hire. An individual treatment team may have more than one intern.
