

Spanish 409A Challenge Exam Study Guide

Instructions: The student will demonstrate the ability to read, write and speak Spanish at the third year College level. The exam consists of 2 parts. Each part has been dividing into the following two components:

- Proctored part, 2 hours to complete:
 - 1. **Reading Component:** The student will choose one reading selection from those provided by testing. There will be questions about the reading sample, and the student must submit a written paragraph about the main theme of the reading selection.
 - 2. **Written Component:** The student will be provided with drawings and will be required to write a dialogue in Spanish about what is happening in the illustrated situations.
- * Take-home part, five days to complete:
 - 3. <u>Student Input:</u> The student must submit an audiotape in which she/he narrates about an assigned topic. The student must submit a written outline about his/her narrative with the audiotape.
 - 4. <u>Cultural Component:</u> The student will select a cultural topic as detailed in the exam. An outline in Spanish about the topic will be submitted with the topics.

Please note: Although the SP409A and SP 409B exams are very similar, they are separate exams. Each must be taken separately, with topics unique to each exam. Call the Testing Center if you have any questions.
