# 10 REASONS TO CHOOSE REGIS

## 1. GRADUATION RATE

- Regis student-athletes have a graduation rate of 81 percent and an academic success rate of 92 percent, the highest marks in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (NCAA Academic Success Rates Report). Regis was also awarded the NCAA President's Award for achieving at least a 90 percent ASR over a four-year span

## 2. ACADEMIC SUCCESS
