




- Things you should think about when you choose a career







What the Healthcare Sector Looks Like to the Casual






- Regis offers career success and educational flexibility

The dual degree programs are achieved by applying electives taken within the PharmD program to the targeted MS programs



- Regis offers generous tuition assistance packages based upon financial need, scholastic performance and application timing
 - Students who complete a verified application by Feb 3, 2025 are eligible for a \$6,000 tuition assistance bonus in addition to the standard package
 - Final out of pocket costs for the average student at Regis are on par with comparable institutions

 Participate in the interview process On Campus or Virtual 	Standard Enrollment Deadline June 2 • Standard Tuition Assistance
 Hold acceptance with a deposit Complete outstanding pre-requisites 	Final Enrollment Deadline • Tuition Assistance May be Limited June 15
You do not have to waited until you have completed all of your pre-requisites to apply if your intention is to finish them prior to enrollment	Acceptance is offered to students on a rolling basis as soon as 2-3 weeks after application completion, based upon timing and completion of interview process
