The Regis M.S. in Health Services Administration is much like an MBA, but specialized for the complexities of health care. You'll gain the legal, financial, management and administrative skills needed to keep major health care companies and organizations running smoothly and efficiently. You'll also have the opportunity to affect systemic and structural issues within our health systems to enhance patient care and the overall patient experience. Courses in leadership, strategy, finance, organizational ethics, operations, research and technology management will build upon your DO courses and experiences to provide you with a deeper appreciation of the social and ethical obligations and complexities involved in providing health care. Courses are taught by faculty-administrators who are health care professionals and multidisciplinary industry experts.

You might be wondering:

- IN WHAT FORMAT ARE CLASSES HELD? Classes are taught online in 8-week terms.
- WHEN CAN I ATTEND? Dual degree students should plan on completing six Regis MS-HSA courses before beginning their RVU DO program. Three additional Regis courses must be completed after finishing the DO degree, for a total of nine Regis courses (three other required HSA courses are accepted from the RVU DO curriculum).
